In the academic year 2018-2019, Science Association has organized various programs and activities. The brief account of these events is given as below:

1. Welcome Function

In the beginning of the academic year 2018-2019, college has organised welcome function for the newly admitted students for B. Sc. course. In this function, Science Association played a vital role. At this time, students were made aware about the scope of B.Sc., opportunities after B. Sc., examination pattern, syllabus, different facilities, co-curricular courses in the college etc. Further, students were welcomed by offering a plant and sweet.

2. Acquaintance with Scholarships

Students were also made acquainted with different scholarships such as Kishor Vaidnanik Protsahan Yojana, Malhotra Weikfield Foundation etc.

3. Avishkar Competition

We arranged Gopal Krishna Gokhale College Avishkar poster and model competition in our college in which 29 students were presented their posters and models. The exhibition was inaugurated by Hon. Secretary of Shikshan Prasarak Mandal in the presence of Hon. Patron Council member Daulatrao Desai. Posters and models were assessed by three examiners namely Dr. D. V. Awale, Mr. S. R. Ghatage and Mr. S. S. Desai. Four winners were rewarded by offering certificates. These winners were guided and encouraged to participate in the Avishkar Competition of Shivaji University, organised at Vijaysinha Yadav College, Peth-Vadgaon. Participants received certificates.

4. National Science Day Celebration

On the occasion of National Science Day on 28th February, we organised a Science Week in which different competitions such as poster/model presentation, essay competition, game competition, visits and participation in different events at various levels were planned. Accordingly, a) in essay competition almost 90 students were participated, b) in game competition 30 students were involved, c) students of nutrition and dietetics were visited to Aster Adhar hospital and explained the importance of proper diet to maintain good health, d) two students namely Ajay Porlekar and Sanchit Dalvi participated in elocution and model presentation respectively in the university level completion organised by School of Nanoscience, Shivaji University, Kolhapur in which Ajay Porlekar stood second and received silver medal and certificate, e) ten students were participated in the national level PUBG competition organised by Bharati Vidyapeeth, Kolhapur and secured first prize and f) eight students were participated in the national level debate competition organised by Bharati Vidyapeeth, Kolhapur.

5. Tribute to C. V. Raman

On the occasion of National Science Day, a floral tribute was paid by faculty and students to Sir C. V. Raman and recalled his vital contribution to Indian science and to the world in the form of 'Raman Effect'.
